APPLICATION FOR RE-EXHIBITING OF
DOCUMENTS DURING THE COURSE OF
EXAMINATION IN CHIEF OF PROSECUTION
WITNESSES.

1) The present accused trial has been commenced recently in view of the order of passed by the Hon'ble High Court of judicature of Bombay dated 9/7/21 in Criminal Application No. 122/14 and PIC No. 15/20. The present accused is directed to be tried separately from the other co-accused being R.C.C. No. 147/2002, that thereafter conclusion of the said trial.

- 2) That in compliance of the above said order judgment in case of co-accused has been delivered after completion of their trial and present accused is put to trial.
- 3) That, till date total three prosecution witness has been examine and during course of evidence this Hon'ble Court relied upon old exhibits which were given numbers during the trial of Sunil Kedar and others.
- 4) The, present applicant submit that, present applicant has given separate trial as per order mentioned above Hon'ble High Court has not whispered a single word about the manner of trial to be conducted by the learned trial court, therefore as accused is facing the trial independently which is nothing but denovo trial where in entire record has to be relied upon and examined independently

irrespective of what has been done during the course of earlier trial for the accused.

5) In view of the above said fact and circumstances of the case fresh/re-exhibit Numbers be given to documents relied upon the prosecution and referred to prosecution witness and proved from them which will give fair trial to present accused as accused was never present during previous trial as well as documents were exhibited during the course of trial of Mr. Sunil Kedar and others.

6) That this Hon'ble Court is duty bound to examine the witness and give the fresh exhibit Nos. to document which is proved in accordance with law as deposing the present accused is entitled for a fair trial and would cause injustice to him and would be against principle of fair trial and order to that effect would subjudice justice and for which act of

kindness this the present applicant/accused would remain obelized.

Hence this application.

PRAYER :- It is therefore prayed that this Hon'ble Court may be pleased to re-exhibit of documents during the course of examination in Chief of prosecution witnesses and not to reliable on exhibits in the interest of justice.
