## ORDER BELOW EXH.64.

(Dt:24.03.2003)

1. Perused the application and say given by learned SFP. Heard both the sides and perused the record.
2. Learned counsel for accused Sanjay Agrawal submits that on 7.1.03 this court passed an order below Exh.39 and re-considered the quantum of bail amount in the light of direction of Hon'ble 6th ADJ, Nagpur, in Cri.Revision.No.539/02, dated 30.12.02. By order below Exh.39 accused/applicant Sanjay Agrawal directed to release on furnishing one or two solvent surety of Rs.1lakh with PR bond of like amount along with some other conditions. He further submits that as accused is in jail. Therefore, he has unable to procure solvent surety and thus in <sup>lieu</sup> ~~leave~~ of bail he prayed for releasing accused on depositing cash amount. Learned SPP however, objected for the same.
3. On perusal of order below Exh.39 it do reveals that accused Sanjay Agrawal was directed to release on bail on furnishing one or two solvent surety of Rs.1 lakh each with PR bond of of like amount on some conditions. Since the date of passing that order also the accused Sanjay Agrawal is in jail and in MCR in this crime. Which itself is sufficient to demonstrate his inability to furnish solvent surety. Under such circumstances I found no hurdle in the way of applicant

accused Sanjay Agrawal for depositing cash security in ~~lieu~~ <sup>lieu</sup> of bail. Hence, I proceed to pass the following order.

ORDER

- (1) Accused Sanjay Hariram Agrawal be released on depositing cash amount of Rs.50,000/- in ~~lieu~~ <sup>lieu</sup> of solvent surety as given below order Exh.39. The rest conditions are same as given ~~below~~ <sup>in the</sup> order below Exh.39.
