State -- Vs – Sunil & Ors

**ORDER BELOW EXH.3719**

Read the application. Say not filed. It is contended that, the mother of applicant/accused has passed away on 21.10.2025. It is further contended that, the applicant/accused is required to attend post funeral rituals, therefore, the applicant/accused is unable to attend this Court in compliance of directions of the Hon'ble High Court in Criminal Application No.01/2024.

By order dated 09.01.2024, in Criminal Application No.01/2024, the Hon'ble High Court Bench at Nagpur has directed the applicant/accused to attend this Court on first day of every month and this Court was directed to record his presence. By the said order, the applicant/accused was directed not to apply for exemption, unless there are exceptional circumstances. Thus, the applicant/accused could apply for exemption only under exceptional circumstances. As stated above, the mother of applicant/accused has passed away on 21.10.2025 and he is required to attend post funeral rituals. Under these circumstances, personal exemption can be granted to the applicant/accused for today.

In view of the above, the applicant/accused can be permitted to appear virtually through video conferencing. Accordingly, the applicant/accused has appeared before this Court virtually through video conferencing at 12.35 p.m. Hence, exemption is granted to the applicant/accused for his personal appearance before this Court for today.
