State -- Vs – Sunil & Ors

COMMON ORDER BELOW EXH.3724 & 3725

1) Application Exh.3724 is made by accused No.3 for grant of exemption and application Exh.3725 is for grant of adjournment of 20 days. In the applications, it is contended that, accused No.3 has been hospitalized on 16.11.2025. It is further contended that, the accused would remain present after a period of 20 days as per the advice of the concerned doctor. The Ld. APP has objected the application. It is submitted that, charge can be framed through video conferencing. The accused is delaying the trial by seeking adjournment of 20 days. The accused has already prolonged the matter on one pretext or the other.

2) The matter is for framing charge against accused No.3. The said accused has produced photocopy of Medical Certificate dated 17.11.2025 below list Exh.3727. The said certificate has been issued by Dr. M.A.Kasem. It is certified that, accused No.3 is suffering from COPDT T2RF(Type-II respiration failure) and under treatment from 16.11.2025. It is further certified that, accused No.3 is to continue life saving treatment at Hospital till recovery. There is no document to show that, the accused has been advised Hospitalization for 20 days.

3) The matter is quite old. There are directions for

expeditious disposal of said case. The charge against accused No.3 can be framed through video conferencing. Hence, the application Exh.3725 seeking adjournment of 20 days is rejected. Exemption is granted to accused No.3 for today. Accused No.3 shall remain present either physically or through video conferencing on 21.11.2025 for framing of charge.
