

3. That in the meantime, the prosecution has commenced examination of witnesses and the matter is being proceeded with for recording evidence.
4. It is respectfully submitted that unless and until the documents sought under Section 207 Cr.P.C. are supplied to the Applicant, it is not possible for the Applicant to effectively cross-examine the prosecution witnesses.
5. That non-supply of such documents seriously prejudices the right of the Applicant to defend himself and violates the principles of fair trial.
6. That If the witnesses are examined in absence of supplying the relevant documents, the Applicant will be deprived of properly putting forth his defence and the entire proceedings would stand vitiated.
7. That therefore, it is just and necessary that the application under Section 207 Cr.P.C. is decided first, and only thereafter the matter be proceeded with for recording of evidence.

PRAYER :-

In view of the above, it is most respectfully prayed that this Hon'ble Court may be pleased to:

- a) Decide the application filed under Section 207 Cr.P.C. at the earliest;
- b) Direct that further examination of prosecution witnesses be deferred till disposal of the said application and supply of documents to the Applicant;
- c) Defer further proceedings of recording of evidence till disposal of the said application and compliance thereof;
- d) Pass any other order in the interest of justice.
