

ORDER BELOW EXHIBIT NO.1

(CNR No. MHOS03-000396-2002)

Today, matter is fixed for recording of evidence of accused No.7.

2. It is to be noted that the present matter is of the year 2002. Further, Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in Petition(s) for Special Leave to Appeal (Cri) (Nos.)10625-10626/2024, vide its order dated 09.01.2026 has specifically directed this Court to make an endeavor to dispose of the matter within a period of six months after framing the charges. Perusal of record shows that the charge has been re-framed on 15.01.2026 and therefore, as per the directions of Hon'ble Apex Court, the present matter is required to be disposed of **on or before 15.07.2026**.

3. Record and roznama clearly shows that since 17.11.2025 the present case was pending for recording of statement of accused No.7 U/sec. 313 of Cr.P.C. As the accused failed to remain present for recording of his statement on 30.03.2026, NBW came to be issued against him. Thereafter, on 06.04.2026 proclamation came to be issued against the accused. The accused challenged the order of issuance of NBW passed by this Court by filing Cri. Rev. Application No. 128/2026 before the Hon'ble Bombay High Court, Bench at Aurangabad. In the said Revision Application, Hon'ble High Court vide its order dated 08.04.2026, directed this Court not to take coercive action against the accused. The said order was continued till 12.06.2026. While the above said order of the Hon'ble High Court was in force, on 10.06.2026, the accused No.7 voluntarily surrendered before the Court. As the proclamation U/sec. 82 of Cr.P.C. was issued against the accused vide

order passed below Exh. 1153, therefore, the accused was taken into the custody and on the same day he was released on PR. Bond of Rs.50,000/-. Further, on 10.06.2026 the statement of accused No.7 U/sec.313 of Cr.PC. came to be recorded vide Exh.1181 and matter posted today for defence evidence.

4. At the cost of repetition it is necessary to mention here that since 17.11.2025, the present case was pending only for recording of statement of this accused U/sec. 313 of Cr.PC. The statement of accused No.7 U/sec. 313 of Cr.PC. has been recorded on 10.06.2026 and today matter is posted for evidence of accused No.7. As stated herein above, the Hon'ble Appex Court in Special Leave to Appeal (Cri) (Nos.)10625-10626/2024, vide its order dated 09.01.2026, specifically directed to this Court to make an endeavor to dispose of the matter within a period of six months after framing the charges. Further, the charge has been re-framed on 15.01.2026 and therefore, as per the directions of Hon'ble Apex Court, the present matter is required to be disposed of **on or before 15.07.2026**. Admittedly there is no stay order in Cri. Rev. Application No. 128/2026 by the Hon'ble Bombay High Court, Bench at Aurangabad. Under such circumstances, case is required to be disposed of within one month. Under such circumstances, it is necessary to conduct the case day to day, until it is disposed of. Hence, the prosecution and all the accused are directed to take note that henceforth with present case will be conducted on day to day basis, until it is disposed of. Accordingly, prosecution and all the accused are directed to take note of it and cooperate the Court in disposing of present case.
